3. Vacancies of Board members who are not officers shall be filled with a member from their team, as designated by the team Captain.

Removal of Officers;

- Any Member of the Board, whether appointed or elected by the membership who is unable or unwilling may be removed from office only by a vote of two thirds (2/3) of the remaining Board.

Article VI: Adoption and Amendment

The above bylaws shall be introduced to all members of GMDBC for review and discussion one month prior to voting on their acceptance or rejection. The bylaws shall be linked to the GMDBC website so all members shall may have access to them. The following month, each GMDBC member shall have two weeks to cast their vote to adopt or reject these bylaws. Once a quorum has been established as described in Article III of these bylaws, a majority vote shall determine the outcome of the vote. If approved, these bylaws shall be adopted by GMDBC and replace any previous bylaws and amendments. These bylaws may be amended by Board recommendation and the majority vote of the members, following procedures described in this paragraph.
