## Section VI. International Competition Training

Sections I and 2 remain the same as written, existing Section 3 becomes renumbered to 4 and the following is inserted.

3. With proper written notification to GMDBC Board non-residents of The Villages may practice with any team in preparation for a specific international competition. Non-residents will be permitted to practice with the designated team commencing sixty (60) prior to the beginning of the competition and continuing through the duration of the event. Teams will be restricted to practicing on Lake Miona when non-residents are paddling.
