Vice President Report:

- 1) Safety Update
 - a) Mary reviewed safety considerations for dragon boating
 - i) See the GMDBC web site Safety page for specifics
 - b) Hydration is critical during the summer months; be sure to have water on the boat with you
 - c) Be aware of weather conditions; tornado warnings/watches, white caps and thunder mean get off the lake quickly and safely
 - i) Wait at least 30 minutes after last sound of thunder to go back out on the water
 - d) Excessive heat
 - i) Villages activities are cancelled at "feels like" temps of 104 degrees or more
 - e) Distress indicator
 - i) Indicate personal distress by raising your paddle straight up and telling your seatmate
 - ii) Emergency exits from Lakes Sumter and Miona were reviewed
 - f) Check location of AEDs at the lakes; know where they are
 - g) Where Am I app is one phone app which can be used to specify your location in an emergency

- 2. Boat Maintenance and Lake matters, Laura Reynolds for Beth Bowen
