Opening: Meeting was called to order at 1:00 PM

Secretary's Report:

- 1. August board meeting minutes were posted prior to the meeting
 - a. A motion to approve minutes by John, with 2nd by Linda, passed unanimously.

President's Report:

- 1. Boat purchases
 - a. The Villages purchase of one (1) new boat, including equipment and trailer is in process
 - i. The Villages will also provide 40 paddles, 40 adult PFDs and 20 youth PFDs
 - ii. New boat will be placed at Lake Sumter or stored until Eastport location is ready
 - b. Purchase of additional boats will be discussed in early 2025
 - i. Discussion regarding concerns with the newly purchased BUK boat, including lack of lift handles and foot ledges inside the boat, agility/speed of the boat and seat surfaces were noted. These concerns will be considered prior to the purchase of any additional boats.

 - a. Don will review club Safety Guidelines and discuss PFD safety
 - b. Captains please encourage your team members to attend

Boat Maintenance:

 - i. Linda and Beth completed replacing carpet on dollies at Lake Sumter
 - ii. Lynn volunteered Eastport Sun Dragons to repair the dollies at Lake Miona
 - c. Communication to Captains and Boat Maintenance

- b. 10 person boat cover at Miona
 - i. Additional clamps and bungees were added
 - ii. Please ensure that the straps which go under and around each end of the boat are in place; these tighten the cover and prevent puddling water
- c. 20-person boat covers at Miona
 - i. Boat 5 frame is complete. The other 20-person boat frame has been strengthened
 - ii. Ken is monitoring and adjusting each as needed
- d. Extra fittings and parts are in the storage unit when needed
- 5. Purple Boat
 - a. Ken is assessing the boat for his project
 - b. Ski Beach is alternate plan
 - c. Plan to resolve status of the purple boat by year end in order to make room in storage for another boat
